KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK VILLAGE OF MANCELONA, MICHIGAN ord. no. 58 eff. Oct. 9, 1971; amend. Ord. 104 of 2015 eff. September 8, 2015

WHEREAS, it appears that the health of the inhabitants of the Village of Mancelona may be endangered, it is hereby ordained that no person shall keep or maintain horses, cows, calves, swine, sheep, goats, geese, bees or beehives in any dwelling or part thereof within the Village limits of said Village. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance upon conviction shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than \$500 or ninety (90) days in the county jail or both.
