In fulfillment of the requirements of the Municipal Planning Enabling Act (PA33 of 2008 as amended), the Mancelona Area Planning Commission presents the following report covering significant action by the Commission for calendar year 2022:

### **Master Plan:**

**The Mancelona Area Master Plan was finalized in 2018. The Plan will be up for renewal in 2023.**

### **Recreation Plan:**

The Mancelona Area also has a joint Recreation Plan. This was put in place in 2018. This plan will be up for review by 2023.

### **Zoning:**

The Mancelona Area Planning Commission does not govern Zoning. The Zoning is taken care of by the Village Planning Commission that consists only of the Village of Mancelona. Mancelona Township does not have Zoning.

### **Special Land Use:**

The Planning Commission did not receive or consider and rezoning requests for the year.

### **Training:**

### **Accomplishments for 2022:**

- The state of Michigan investment dollars for the sewer expansion heading north along US 131 past McDonalds and BP gas station.
- The Planning Commission also supported the CRD in their efforts to secure grants of all purposes for the area.

### **Goals for 2023:**

- Set up meeting with new county Parks and Rec Coordinator to discuss Wetzell Lake, Palmer Park and other outdoor areas in the Village and the Township.
- The Village is still bidding out improvements to Palmer Park from a grant secured through the DNR that was selected in 2020 (covid created difficulties in completing this task at the time)
- Continue to support Affordable/Workforce Housing efforts, including housing improvement and blight grants. Support the new housing development off Kresnak Rd as necessary.
- Work with Eagle and Janice Addams to consider how to sell CRD owned properties.
- Contact NLEA, David Emmanuel, for assistance in what can be done with the DURA property.
- The Mancelona Area Planning Commission will update the Master Plan and Rec Plan in preparation for 2023.
- Continue to support the CRD in grant finding for the Mancelona Area.
